The Special Trophy presented by R P McInally, Dykecroft, Lesmahagow must be won three times in succession or four times in all before becoming the property of the exhibitor. The prize money will be £35, £30, £25,£15 and special prizes will be presented for 5^{th} and 6^{th} places.

RULES

- Only competing dogs are allowed in field and they must be kept under chain. The committee reserves the right to remove any dog considered to be unfit for any cause.
- The Judge has full power to disqualify any dog injuring sheep and the owner of the dog will be liable for any damage caused.
- Each competitor must see his sheep penned after the run.
- Any competitor disobeying the judge or official will be disqualified.
- No person will be allowed with competing dogs other than handler who will be placed where the judge directs. No dog may be run by two competitors.
- Subject to objection prize money will be paid on field.
- The Judge's decision will be final on all points.
- Any objection must be lodged in writing to the Secretary or Trials Convenor accompanied by fee of £10 within 30 minutes of the completion of the trials. The fee is returnable if upheld.
- Each competitor is allowed to run a maximum of two dogs.
- Only one run per competitor is allowed after 1.00p.m.
