Notice to exhibitors:

- **PLEASE NOTE:** Change in MV Accreditation rules:
All accredited sheep owners must report to the steward on entry to the show to have MV/CAE Health Declaration validated and **COLLECTED** prior to unloading. Please ensure all forms are completed before arriving at the showfield.
- Sheep must be put in pens allocated to them.
- Where there is no entry fee there will be no prize money.
- Prize money will be collected from the steward.
- Entry costs are £2 per class plus £5 membership fee per exhibitor.
- Prize money – 1st - £6, 2nd - £4 and 3rd - £2 unless otherwise stated.
- The Champion in each breed is eligible to compete in the overall Interbreed Championship.
