- 12 Clydesdale Horse Society Shield  
A shield which will be supplied and engraved by The Clydesdale Horse  
Society will be presented to the best yearling or two year old colt or filly,  
registered or eligible for registration with the Society, not having won a  
Shield before in its lifetime. The exhibitor must be a current member of  
The Clydesdale Horse Society.      *No entry fee*
- 13 Young Handlers Class  
An engraved medal is presented by The Clydesdale Horse Society to the  
best young handler aged 12 to 16 on day of the show who has not  
already qualified. That person will also receive a Young Handlers  
qualifier rosette on the day of the show. The capabilities of the handler  
are to be assessed, not the animal being led. The qualifiers from eligible

shows in the period 1 May 2019 – 30 April 2020 will be eligible to compete in the final at the Royal Highland Show in 2020. Qualifiers from the period 1 May 2020 to 30 April 2021 will qualify for the final at the Royal Highland Show in 2021. A merit rosette will be given to all entrants. *No entry fee*
