Notice to exhibitors:

- **PLEASE NOTE:** Change in MV Accreditation rules: All accredited sheep owners must report to the steward on entry to the show to have MV/CAE Health Declaration validated and **COLLECTED** prior to unloading. Please ensure all forms are completed before arriving at the showfield.
- Sheep must be put in pens allocated to them.
- Where there is no entry fee there will be no prize money.
- Prize money to be collected from the steward.
- Entry costs are £3 per class plus £5 membership fee per exhibitor.
- Prize money – 1st - £6, 2nd - £4 and 3rd - £2 unless otherwise stated.
- The Champion in each breed is eligible to compete in the overall Interbreed Championship.

The Scottish Area Branch of the Suffolk Sheep Society Male & Female of the Year, the branch will supply a Male and Female Champion Rosette which will be awarded to the highest placed MV Accredited Scottish Male and Female forward at each show, selected by the show judge.
