Notice to exhibitors:

- Herd/ear numbers will be taken on the field for verification.
- Make sure all animals are brought into the ring on time.
- Portable milking machine available on the field.
- No stock to be removed from field before 3pm.
- Where there is no entry fee there will be no prize money.
- Prize money to be collected from the convenor.
- Online entry fee £5 per exhibit, £7 on the day, £5 membership fee per exhibitor.
- Prize Money: 1st £10, 2nd £7, 3rd £3 unless otherwise stated.
- All exhibitors must prove a BVD negative status, any animals from a “not negative” herd will be refused entry to the showground.
- **Judging will start at 10am.**
