

# Horse and Pony Section

## Notice to Exhibitors:

- Riding hats of one of the following standards must be worn: PAS 015 2011 with BSI Kitemark, VG1 with BSI Kitemark, Snell E2016 onwards with the official Snell label and number, ASTM-F1163 2004a onwards with the SEI mark, AS/NZS 3838, 2006 onwards.
- Riding boots of a good standard must be worn.
- Judges/convenors decision is final.
- Classes may be combined/split at convenors discretion.
- Entries accepted on the day, up to 15 minutes before class due to start.
- Passports should accompany animals to the show.
- For classes marked with an asterisk\* Mountain and Moorland breed registration is not necessary. M & M type animals are acceptable.
- Entries are accepted online.

| 2            | Confined Showing                                     | Ridden pony / horse. No entry fee. Rider and owner confined to Lesmahagow parish. Passport may be requested as proof of eligibility. C.L. Hamilton Trophy |
| 3            | Lead Rein<br>Mountain & Moorland *<br>or riding pony | Pony not exceeding 12.2hh. Riders 8 years old and under. Class will be split if necessary.  |
| 4            | In Hand<br>Mountain & Moorland *<br>or riding pony   | 3 years and under. Small and large breeds will be judged separately<br>Class will be split if necessary.  |
| 5            | In Hand<br>Mountain & Moorland *<br>or riding pony   | 4 years and over. Small and large breeds will be judged separately<br>Class will be split if necessary.   |
| 6            | Ridden<br>Mountain & Moorland *<br>or riding pony    | 4 years and over. Small and large breeds will be judged separately.<br>Class will be split if necessary.  |
| 7            | First Pony   | Suitable for novice child. No lead rein. Rider 12 and under. Riders will walk and trot only, but may canter in individual show.                           |

| Class | Name                         | Details  |
|-------|------------------------------|--|
| 8     | Show hunter / Riding Pony    | 15hh and under   |
| 9     | Coloured Horse or Pony       | Ridden   |
| 10    | Show Hunter / Riding Horse   | Exceeding 15hh   |
| 11    | Riding Club Horse / Pony     | Riders 17 years and over. May be asked to jump.                            |
| 12    | Pony Club Horse / Pony       | Riders 16 years and under. Prize for the best rider. May be asked to jump. |
| 13    | Ridden Veteran Horse / Pony  | Horse / pony to be over 15 years old.                                      |
| 14    | In hand Veteran Horse / Pony | Horse / pony to be over 15 years old.                                      |
| 15    | Family Horse / Pony          | Ridden or in hand. A chance for the family's faithful friend to shine!     |

**Supreme Championship** – 1st and 2<sup>nd</sup> from classes 1 -15 will be called back into the ring for the supreme championship judging.

| 16    | Young Handler | <u>10 years and under</u> . Competitors will be expected to lead in walk and trot, and lift the pony's hooves. |
| 17    | Young Handler | <u>11 years and over</u> . Competitors will be expected to lead in walk and trot, and lift the pony's hooves.  |
| 18    | Fancy Dress   | No entry fee.  |
