Notice to exhibitors:

- **PLEASE NOTE:** All accredited sheep owners must report to the steward on entry to the show to have MV/CAE Health Declaration validated and **COLLECTED** prior to unloading. Please ensure all forms are completed before arriving at the show field.
- Sheep must be put in pens allocated to them.
- Where there is no entry fee there will be no prize money.
- Prize money to be collected from the steward.
- Online entry fee £3 per exhibit, £5 on the day, £5 membership fee per exhibitor.
- Prize money: 1<sup>st</sup> £6, 2<sup>nd</sup> £4, 3<sup>rd</sup> £2 unless otherwise stated.
- The Champion in each breed is eligible to compete in the overall Interbreed Championship.
